

Canadian Food Inspection Agency Establishes Primary Control Zones and Movement Permitting Process

April 5, 2022

In response to the presence of Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI), the Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA) has now established Primary Control Zones 1 and 2 to control risks associated with movement of poultry and poultry products moving in, out and/or through these areas. The CFIA has now posted the movement control permissions. Please access this information to determine which type of permit you require.

Specific Permits

Anyone requiring specific permits for immediate movement should reach out to CFIA by calling 519-953-6658, 8 am to 6 pm (EST), or email:

General Permits

The General Permit must be filled out with the specifics of the movement and a copy must be kept with each movement of the commodity. (Note: The recommended browser is Internet Explorer; alternatively try downloading the file first and then opening.)
