

## H5 Avian Influenza in the Town of Amherstburg

February 20, 2026

**This is an important communication regarding biosecurity and quarantine provisions on your poultry farm.**

The Feather Board Command Centre (FBCC) was made aware of symptoms consistent with H5 avian influenza (HPAI) in a poultry flock in the Town of Amherstburg. [CLICK HERE](#) to access the FBCC biosecurity advisory area advisory map.

### CFIA Primary Control Zones

CFIA has implemented [movement control permissions](#). Please access this information to determine which type of permit you may require.
